2. PF	2 <sup>nd</sup> Advanced Course (LK)	written examination
3. PF	Standard Course (GK)	written examination (not possible in Physics and Chemistry)
4. PF	Standard Course (GK)	oral examination before the school's examination board
5. PF	Basic Course (GK) as a subject to refer to; second subject, if applicable	presentation <u>or</u> 20-page subject essay plus examination discussion
